

# How to play Roulette

## Origins of Roulette

Roulette originated in France over three hundred years ago. It is a fun and easy game to play and offers a wide variety of payoff odds.

## The Numbers:

The Roulette Wheel is marked with numbers 1 through 36 and the symbols “0” and “00.” The numbers are colored red and black. The “0” and “00” are green. Color and number combinations offer a variety of betting options. Wagers can be placed on individual numbers or groups of numbers.

## Colored Chips (no cash value):

Roulette chips are different from other casino chips. Each player receives a different color chip in order to keep track of their individual bets. The player decides the value of the chip when they buy in, if they would like the value of their chips to be greater than the table minimum. Roulette chips are sold in “stacks” of 20. For example, if you would like your roulette chips to be worth \$1 each, you would purchase a “stack” for \$20. Since roulette chips are special to the roulette table, you will need to exchange your roulette chips for casino chips before leaving the game.

## The Action

While bets are being placed, the dealer spins the roulette ball in the opposite direction of the spinning wheel.

Bets may be placed until the dealer announces “no more bets” as the ball begins to drop. When the ball falls into a number on the roulette wheel the dealer places a marker on the winning number on the table layout and pays the winning bets.

## Ways to Bet

The diagram below indicates the payoffs for a single-chip bet and the many combinations available:

|   | <u>Wager</u>           | <u>Payoff</u> | <u>Nickname</u> |
|---|------------------------|---------------|-----------------|
| A | Single Number          | 35 to 1       | Straight Up     |
| B | Two Numbers            | 17 to 1       | Split           |
| C | Three Numbers          | 11 to 1       | Street Bet      |
| D | Four Numbers           | 8 to 1        | Corner          |
| E | Five Numbers           | 6 to 1        | 0, 00, 1, 2, 3  |
| F | Six Numbers            | 5 to 1        | Double Street   |
| G | Twelve Numbers         | 2 to 1        | Dozens          |
| H | Twelve Numbers         | 2 to 1        | Column          |
| I | One to Eighteen        | 1 to 1        | First Eighteen  |
| J | Nineteen to Thirty-Six | 1 to 1        | Last Eighteen   |
| K | Red or Black           | 1 to 1        |                 |
| L | Odd or Even            | 1 to 1        |                 |
