MORE WAYS TO WIN!

The Fun is Here!

Uses standard decks with 10's removed

Player Blackjack

Always Beats dealer's Blackjack - pays 3/2

Player total of 21

Always Beats dealer's total of 21, pays up to 3-1*

Pair Splitting

Player may split cards of equal value including ACES creating up to 4 hands - hitting and doubling of split hands including ACES - is allowed.

Double Down

Double with 2 or more cards, on any total including after splitting. No bonuses on doubled hands.

Double-Double Down

After a double card is drawn, a player may double again, rescue or stand. Players may double the total wager up to three times, once via a double down and twice via double-double down.

Double Down Rescue

After doubling if a player is dissatisfied with his non-busted hand, he may rescue (take back) the last DOUBLED portion of the bet, forfeiting half of the total wager.

Late Surrender Allowed

Player holds suited **7-7-7**

Double-Double-Down

Once a player elects to double and receives a double down card, the player then has the option to Double-Double Down (double his total wager again), Rescue or Stand.

A player may double the total wager up to three times, once via double down and twice via Double-Double Down, creating a maximum wager of 8 times the original wager.

After doubling a third time and receiving a double down card a player's options are to Rescue or Stand.

Match the Dealer[™]

5 Big Payoffs!

Uses standard decks with 10's removed

How to play:

The player makes a Match the Dealer[™] wager by placing a bet in the Match the Dealer[™] bet circle. In order to play Match the Dealer[™], the player must make a regular 21 bet. If either or both the player's first two cards exactly match the dealer's up card in rank or suited rank, the player wins the amount from the pay table below.

Minimum bet is \$1. The house sets the maximum.

Five big Payoffs

1 non-suited match:	pays	4-1
2 non-suited matches:	pays	8-1
1 suited match:	pays	9-1
1 non-suited and 1 suited match:	pays	13-1
2 suited matches:	pays	18-1
