

PROMOTION RULES

- Promotion available to all active Mill Club Members
- Drawings: Sunday, December 17, 2023; 7:00 PM
- Earning period: December 1 - 17, 2023; during Table Games pit hours
- Prizes: six random winners x entry seat at Mini Blackjack Tournament
- Participant must have an open rating and be actively playing during the promotion to qualify for entries
- Qualified players will receive one entry for each: Suited Blackjack, any \$5 winning wager on an optional bet in Blackjack, Players Edge, Pai Gow Poker, a \$10 winning Pair Plus wager on Three Card Poker (Flush or Higher) or any win on live roulette from a Straight Up wager of \$3 or more
- When a player earns an entry, Table Games Staff will record the player's name and Mill Club Card number on the entry and give to qualifier
- Qualified player will be responsible for entries and must turn them in to Table Games/Promotion staff on Sunday, December 17, 2023; 6:00 PM - 6:45 PM
- At 7:00 PM, Promotions and Tables Games Staff will begin drawing six names from the barrel to play in the Blackjack Tournament
- Drawings will be announced in Table Games area only (not over the entire gaming floor)
- Participants must arrive at the promotion area within two minutes of their name being called
- A valid photo ID and Mill Club Card are required to claim prize, if a selected winner is not present, another winner will be selected
- Entries become void and drawing barrel will be emptied after the drawing is completed

TOURNAMENT RULES

- The Blackjack Tournament is intended only for participants winners of a barrel drum drawing and is non-transferable. No exceptions
- Participants will earn drawing tickets from December 1, 2023 at 3:00 PM - December 17 at 7:00 PM. Tickets are earned for certain hands as described
- Participants must be at least twenty-one (21) years of age and a member of the Mill Club to participate in the tournament
- No one under twenty-one (21) years of age will be allowed in the tournament area
- All standard "21" rules will apply unless in conflict with tournament rules, in which case tournament rules shall prevail
- Each participant will be assigned their table and seat assignment by the order of which their ticket was drawn. Six tickets will be drawn at 7:00 PM on December 17, 2023. The winning six participants will be assigned seating at the tournament table and must be present at the start of the tournament
- The tournament will consist of one round with six payers at one table. Twelve hands will be dealt during the round
- It is the participants' responsibility to be in the tournament area 15 minutes prior to the scheduled playing time. Failure to do so may result in elimination
- In the event a player is late to the tournament area or does not show, it will result in a forfeit (position will not be filled)
- Participants will not be allowed to bet on another participant's hand or spot. Participants may only play their own hands during the tournament. Participants can only bet on one wagering spot
- All bets are required to conform to Tournament rules
- All Rounds will consist of ten (12) hands
- Each Participant shall receive \$10,000 in tournament chips at the beginning of the round. Participants will be asked to count down their chips for tournament staff prior to the beginning of play. Also, a countdown of all participants chip will occur after the 9th hand
- The minimum bet for all rounds is \$100 and the maximum bet is \$5,000
- Dealers shall use a standard six-deck shoe throughout the Tournament. Before the session begins, the Dealer will manually shuffle the cards and the Supervisor will insert the yellow cut card into the deck. Each shoe will be dealt down to the yellow cut card, allowing the hand in progress to naturally finish or until all hand has been played. At that time, the cards will be reshuffled, cut by a supervisor and play will continue until the session is complete. All cards will be dealt face up. Participants may not touch cards
- In the event of a misdeal hand, the round will be considered void and re-dealt. "Misdeal" is defined as a card dealt out of sequence. However, if only the first card of the round is placed out of sequence and the second card has not been dealt, the Dealer will move the card to the correct spot

- Participants shall bet on their hands in sequence. Bets must be made in \$100 increments, except for insurance bets. Participants can bet insurance for any amount that is not more than half of the original bet
- All bets and decisions must be made in sequence beginning with the first hand dealt. There will be a Marker indicating who the first bettor will be. The Marker will be handled by the Dealers only. After a bet has been made, the Marker placement cannot be changed or position challenged. The Marker will be moved to the next Participant in clockwise sequence after each hand of play, regardless of the outcome
- Once a bet is placed it cannot be changed or be touched, except by the Dealer to collect or pay. All bets must be placed in the betting area in one move
- When a Dealer calls for insurance, each participant in turn, must either take insurance by placing an appropriate insurance bet or opt not to take insurance and use a hand motion to signal a wave-off. Once the participant waves off or takes insurance, the decision of the participant is final and cannot be changed
- The Dealer must hit on Soft 17
- Participants may elect to Double Down on any first two cards. Participants may split any same value cards up to three (3) times creating four (4) hands except for Aces. Aces may only be split (1) once for a total of two (2) hands. Split aces automatically receive only one card each. A Participant may not split for less than the amount of the original bet. A Participant may not call "Even Money." The Participant must make the insurance bet or wave it off. Surrender is not allowed
- Original bets & Double Downs must be a minimum bet of \$100. All splits must be equal to the original bet
- Once the Participant completes a hand, the participant must wave off the dealer to signal a "stand." Once the Dealer is waved off, the hand is final
- The participant with the highest chip count will be the winner of the tournament (12 hands). The remaining participants will be placed in order from 2nd - 6th place by their chip counts at the end of the tournament (12 hands)
- In the event of a tie at the end of the final scoring, the payout for the tied position and the next position(s) down will be combined and split evenly between the tied players (example: If we have a tie for 1st place between 2 players, 1st and 2nd place prizes will be combined and then split evenly. After that the 3rd place winner will be paid and so on)
- All tournament chips must be separated by denomination and kept in clear view for all participants to see. Participants shall not play with or unnecessarily touch their chips. Participants must keep their chips in full view and in front of them during the Tournament. Chips may not be removed from the table, exchanged, borrowed, or loaned between participants
- Friendly conversation (English Only) is permitted during the tournament. Coaching is NOT allowed.
- Collusive communication, either verbal or visual (e.g. signaling), will not be permitted among participants or between participants and spectators. This may result in disqualification and forfeiture of any prize money
- The use of cell phones, smartphones, personal data assistants ("PDAs") or other mobile devices (e.g., iPads, Kindles) during tournament play is prohibited
- Photography and smoking or use of any tobacco products or products made or derived from tobacco, including "vapor cigarettes" and other "vaping" products are NOT permitted at the tables during tournament play
- By participating in the tournament, all participants agree to abide by all tournament rules, terms and conditions. The rules, terms and conditions of the tournament may be changed by The Mill Casino at any time in its sole and absolute discretion
- Non-negotiable tournament chips will be used in each round of the Tournament. Tournament chips have no cash value, may not be used for any other purpose, and must be returned to The Mill Casino at the end of the session
- Any agreements between Participants, concerning the sharing of Tournament winnings are entered into solely by the Participants and are not endorsed by The Mill Casino. The Mill Casino will not recognize or enforce any of these types of agreements and will not be responsible if certain parties do not honor their agreements
- Employees, members of their households, and/or relatives of The Mill Casino, its subsidiaries, and advertising agencies are ineligible to participate in the tournament
- Any violation of The Mill Casino's Tournament Rules or any Mill Casino rules or policies may result in immediate disqualification of the Participant(s) involved
- Participation in the tournament constitutes participants' agreement to abide by the Official Rules of the Mill Club and of the tournament and the decisions of The Mill Casino. Complete copies of all Mill Casino promotion rules and policies are available at the Mill Club. By participating in the tournament, each participant hereby grants The Mill Casino and

its affiliated companies the right and license to use the participant's name, likeness, photograph, video, or image for promotional purposes without compensation

- The Mill Casino Management will resolve any dispute or situation not covered by these rules and that decision shall be final and binding for all participants in the tournament. Any dispute over these official rules is subject to the investigation and adjudication by the Coquille Indian Tribe Gaming Commission
- The Mill Casino Management reserves the right to change, cancel, or modify this offer and adjust the tournament at its sole discretion without prior notice or liability
- As a condition of the redemption of any prize in this promotion, each winner further agrees to execute an affidavit of eligibility, a publicity release, and a liability release, in the form provided by The Mill Casino
- The Mill Casino reserves the right to deny participation in the tournament or revoke a Mill Club Card account at any time in its sole discretion
- The Mill Casino is not responsible for any typographical or other errors in the printing, the offering, or the administration of the tournament or for any malfunctions, defects, or failure of any equipment, hardware, or software used in connection with the tournament
- Participants in the tournament also hereby agree that all issues and questions concerning these official rules, the tournament shall be governed by the Coquille Indian Tribe Gaming Commission
- The Mill Casino reserves the right to determine, in its sole discretion, that a patron is an "advantage player" and therefore ineligible to participate in the promotion or otherwise limit such individual's participation in the promotion. Any such "advantage player" who is already a member of the Mill Club prior to the commencement of the Promotion may be notified by The Mill Casino prior to the commencement of the promotion of any such ineligibility or limitation determination. Otherwise, any such "advantage player" will be notified by The Mill Casino of any ineligibility or limitation determination as soon as possible after such determination is made
- Any participant that has been trespassed, excluded or barred from The Mill Casino will be disqualified from this promotion and points earned in connection with the promotion shall be forfeited
- Winners are responsible for all applicable taxes and/or other fees and must present their Mill Club Card, valid photo ID, provide social security number and complete all required forms to claim their prize

GENERAL RULES

- Must be 21 or older to participate
